February E-Board meeting minutes were reviewed. The motion was made by M. Van Patten to accept the meeting minutes. The motion was seconded by T. Van Metre. Vote: Unanimous. Motion passed.

Old Issues –

Bargaining – Will be tomorrow March 9th starting at 9:00 a.m. The list of Employer’s Initial Proposal are...Salaries (Cost of Living Adjustments and Pay Freezes) 6% Pers Pickup, Insurance, Unpaid Furloughs/Salary Reduction.

PEBB changes in insurance coverage – AOCE has filed a Demand to Bargain on this issue; changing co-pays and having them be retroactive this will cause financial difficulties for staff members and their families.

Donations –

Patriot Day 2011 Field of Flags sponsorship – This year's event will be September 8th – 11th at Salem Riverfront Park. Over 4,500 flags and banners will once be flown: to remember victims, to honor those military personnel who have fallen since 9-11, to thank Military personnel who currently serve and their families, to thank deployed military personnel and their families, to honor Police, Fire, and Emergency Personnel presently serving. This year's event will have a special tribute to law enforcement and fire fighters from the Oregon Memorials. Other selected charities that will also benefit from this are: National Guard Family Emergency Relief Fund and Exchange Club Child Abuse Prevention Center. Discussion: That we would be a Patriot Sponsor in the amount of \$2,500. This would include our logo printed on materials, sponsorship plaque and an opportunity to read 6 names. This amount the sponsorship needs to be postponed until the General Membership meeting.
